Permanent Basketball Hoop Application Requirements and Process:

- a. The Homeowner must submit the Permanent Basketball Hoop Construction Application to BTCA's Design Review & Compliance Coordinator (DRCC).
A \$100 fee and \$1,000 refundable deposit will apply to all applications.
- b. The applicant must provide a scaled site plan showing the exact location of the hoop, including a landscape plan showing existing and proposed screening. A copy of site plan with the location specified is required (preferably a copy of the current house site plan).
- c. **Applications will be rejected if the DRC determines that adequate screening is not feasible due to the size and configuration of the Home Owner's property.**
- d. The DRC requires a photograph of the proposed location from both the street and side yards.
- e. The BTCA Design Review Coordinator will notify the adjacent neighbors that an application has been submitted for the installation of a permanent basketball hoop through the typical postcard notification process and note responses received.
- f. The applicant must include a signed copy of the Permanent Basketball Hoop Construction Guidelines Application and Terms of Use Agreement.
- g. If additional landscaping is required, Homeowner is responsible for notifying the DRCC for inspection and approval prior to installation of basketball hoop.
- h. The Homeowner is responsible to contact BTCA and the DRCC for final inspection within ten (10) days of completion of entire installation.

BTCA Permanent Basketball Hoop Construction Guidelines

Broken Top Community Association has determined that some custom homes within Broken Top may qualify for permanent basketball hoops. The following neighborhoods do not qualify for basketball hoops: **Arrowood I & II, Bridge Creek Village, Courtyards, Fall Creek, Painted Ridge, Tyrion Sky, and Whisper Ridge.**

Portable basketball hoops will not be permitted after December 31, 2017.

All installations shall conform to Sections 5.09 and 6.05 of the Design Review Regulations & Guidelines.

1) Site Rules and Considerations:

- The location must be as inconspicuous as possible.
- The basketball hoop backboard must be screened from view.
- The slope of the driveway may be a determining factor.
- The basketball hoop must be located at least twenty-five feet (25') from the street or pathway and not located in the setbacks. Pole installations are preferred. Backboards mounted on the home or garage will be considered by the DRC on a case-by-case basis.
- Additional landscaping may be required to provide safety and/or privacy, and **must be installed and approved prior** to the installation of the basketball hoop.
- No court or backboard lighting shall be allowed.
- The impact on or objections from adjacent neighbors will be considered.

2) Basketball Hoop Specifications:

- A transparent or clear acrylic backboard, with no colorful graphics. Or contrasting colors anywhere on the fixture.
- A black pole, black rim, and black net are required.
- There shall be no colorful graphics or contrasting coloring anywhere on the fixture.

Permanent Basketball Hoop Terms of Use Agreement

The executed and signed "Use Agreement" form shall serve as a written agreement between the Homeowner and BTCA granting permission to install and use a permanent basketball hoop according to the Broken Top Rules Resolution:

- 1) Hours of use will be strictly limited to 9:00 am. to 8:00 pm. or sunset, whichever is earliest.
- 2) The Homeowner agrees to abide by the regulations of Broken Top CC&R's regarding excessive noise - Article 12.5c. The homeowner agrees that this precludes large gatherings and loud games in driveways.
- 3) The Homeowner agrees to maintain the basketball hoop to the standards set forth in Article 5.2 of the CC&Rs.
- 4) The Homeowner agrees that there will be adult supervision to minimize the noise impact on neighbors and to maintain safety.
- 5) The Homeowner acknowledges that BTCA may request a modification of the use of the basketball hoop in the event of a neighbor's complaints.
- 6) The Homeowner agrees that upon the sale of the home it shall be required that the basketball hoop be removed prior to the transfer of ownership; unless the buyer submits an application and fee to retain the basketball hoop.

I have read all of the Broken Top Community Association Design Guidelines and agree to follow those guidelines completely.
